NEW STREET NAMES : SUN VALLEY SUBDIVISION Report No. O&C2005/5/3

RECOMMENDATIONS:

That the Committee recommends to Council that two new roads in the Sun Valley subdivision at 67 Meremere Street be named Sun Valley Grove and Sun Valley Way.

1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 This report seeks the Committee's approval for the names Sun Valley Grove and Sun Valley Way for two new roads in the Sun Valley subdivision. A plan showing the streets is attached (refer Appendix 1).

2. SIGNIFICANCE OF DECISION

2.1 The decision sought does not reach any of the thresholds set out in Part 1 of the Decision-making Checklist. The level of compliance required with the Local Government Act 2002 decision-making requirements is therefore lower and consequently it was not necessary to complete Part 2 of the Checklist.

3. BACKGROUND

- 3.1 The developer of the subdivision on the Sun Valley school site at 67 Meremere Street has requested that Council name two new roads in the subdivision.
- 3.2 This matter was considered by the Wainuiomata Community Board at its meeting held on 13 July 2005 and the Board requested further information before making a decision.

3.3 At its meeting held on 24 August 2005 the Board recommended that the two new roads in the Sun Valley subdivision be named Sun Valley Grove and Sun Valley Way.
